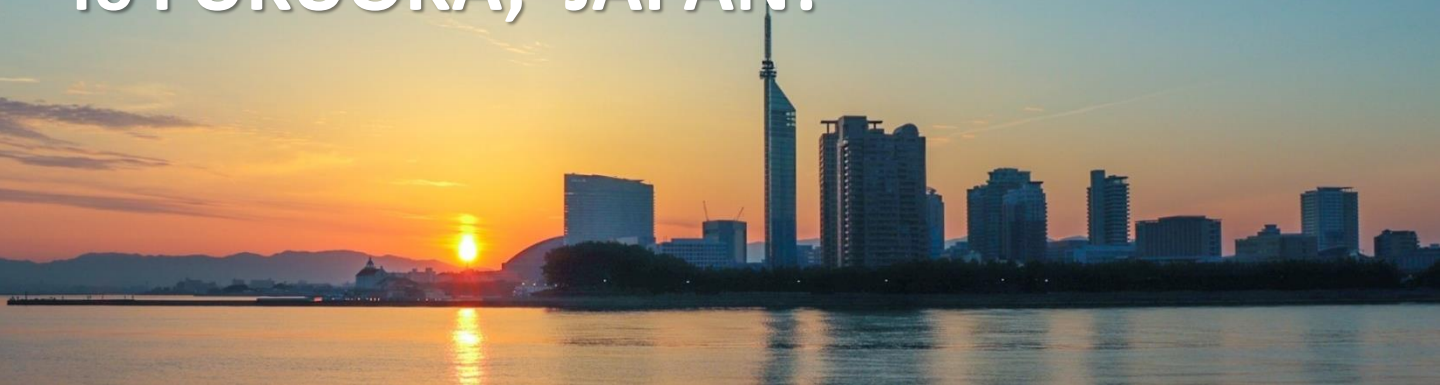
The Japanese Division of the International Academy of Pathology is intending to bid for the IAP 2026 at the ESP/IAP 2020 in Glasgow!

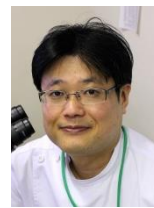

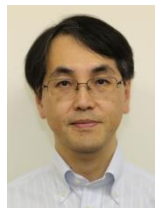

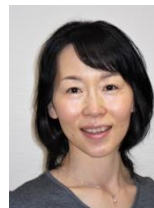
